CODAC OPENS NEW 19,000 SQUARE FOOT TREATMENT CENTER
FOR INTEGRATED PHYSICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH CARE

Tucson, AZ (June 23, 2015) – On Wednesday, June 24, 2015 from 3:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. CODAC Behavioral Health Services will be hosting the Grand Opening of its newest treatment center, CODAC at Cobblestone Court. The general public is invited to attend; confirmed speakers include Mayor Jonathan Rothschild, Representative Victoria Steele and Council Member Karin Uhlich. Representative Randall Friese will also be in attendance.

CODAC at Cobblestone Court is located at 1075 E. Ft. Lowell Road, which is west of Mountain Avenue. The formal ceremony will take place indoors from 3:45 p.m. to 4:15 p.m..

Totaling nearly \$4.2 million in purchase and improvements, the Cobblestone Court campus boasts 19,000 square feet of medical treatment space for primary and specialty care for 3,000 individuals with anxiety, depression and emotional disorders as well as more chronic health conditions such as PTSD, schizophrenia and bipolar disorder. An on-site pharmacy and lab also provides convenient, one-stop services for patients to improve their overall health.

Starting in October, CODAC will have primary care providers on site to provide holistic, person-centered health homes for CODAC clients.

CODAC also purchased the property adjacent to the west, which was converted from a partially-built mini-dorm into a parking lot to ensure adequate parking for the medical complex. CODAC successfully achieved rezoning on this property from the City of Tucson by unanimous vote and through support from the Mountain View and Hedrick Acres Neighborhood Associations.

“This property brings life to a corridor of Ft. Lowell that has been vacant and in need of revitalization for many years now,” says Dennis Regnier, CODAC President and CEO. “CODAC’s investment is not just in a building and a parking lot, but in our staff, our clients and in this community. We’re proud to be new neighbors.”

Construction was completed by BFL Construction Company, Inc., architecture by Eglin Bresler Architects, PC, engineering by Cypress Civil Development, interior design by Within Studios, furniture by Corporate Interior Systems, and financing by Wells Fargo.
